**Appelation** Aconcagua Valley

**Tasting notes** This red blenc presents a deep ruby red color with violet hues. Its complex nose, displays aromas of red fruits, like plum and berries with well-incorporated hints of licorish and mocka. On the mouth, it presents good concentration and volume. This wine is elegant and round, with soft and silky tannins and a persistent finish. Enjoy it with all kinds of red meats and mature cheeses.

## **VINEYARD GROWTH**

Vineyard origin El Encanto Estate, San Felipe.

**Soil** Mountan piedmont. Coluvial soil, mixed of clay and high porcentage of stone with high level of minerals.

**Climate** Temperate. Luminous and warm days, cools nights during summer.

High thermal amplitude.
