Tasting notes This red blend presents a deep ruby red color with violet hues. Its complex nose, displays aromas of red fruits, like plum and berries with well-incorporated hints of licorish and mocka. On the mouth, it presents good concentration and volume. This wine is elegant and round, with soft and silky tannins and a persistent finish. Enjoy it with all kinds of red meats and mature cheeses.

VINEYARD GROWTH

Vineyard origin El Encanto Estate, San Felipe.

Soil Mountain piedmont. Coluvial soil, mixed of clay and high percentage of stone with high level of minerals.

Climate Temperate. Luminous and warm days, cools nights during summer. High thermal amplitude.

HARVEST

Hand picked. From March to April, 2019.

WINEMAKING HIGHLIGHTS

Winery Viña Cono Sur. Santa Elisa Estate. Chimbarongo

Ageing process 100% in French oak barrels during 16 months and 1 month in stainless steel tanks.

Date of bottling October 2020.
